

Welcome

Welcome to Ghyll Royd Care Home, a family-owned care home in the semi-rural area of Guiseley, near Ilkley and Otley.

Ghyll Royd is a purpose-built home, designed to the highest specifications. We pride ourselves on putting our residents' needs first, taking great care to provide a homely, warm, and welcoming environment.

Moving into a care home can feel like a big change, and our aim has always been to support all residents and their families to make their transition as comfortable as possible.





Our Home

We have four communities at Ghyll Royd; Willow, Rowan, Blossom and Beech. Across our communities we offer General Nursing, Dementia Nursing, Dementia Residential and Palliative Care.

Willow & Rowan Communities

Our Willow & Rowan Communities provide up to 46 residents with general nursing care. Working closely with residents' GPs and other Healthcare Professionals, the Nurses and Care Staff are on duty 24 hours a day to provide high quality, person centred care.

We work closely with every resident to tailor a personalised care plan to help ensure their independence and choices are maximised and respected. This plan is added to throughout the residents time with us, continually becoming more detailed.

Getting to know our residents and their wishes is very important to us and we will always include them and their loved ones in the care planning process.



Blossom & Beech Communities

Surrounded by trees and lawns, our Blossom & Beech Communities support residents living with dementia in a calm and peaceful setting.

Both communities enjoy large lounge dining areas, complimented by smaller private lounges surrounded by woodland. In these spaces, we use recollections, reminiscence and sensory-based activities to gain insight into a resident's life stories.

We ensure that the environment we offer changes with the needs of our residents, which is why we continually develop Blossom & Beech with those living with dementia in mind.

Blossom is our Residential Dementia Community, supporting residents who are living with dementia, but who don't need nursing care. Should residents develop the need for nursing care, they can be transferred to our Dementia Nursing Community*, Beech, to be supported by our registered nurses. *Subject to availability

With an excellent knowledge of dementia, our care staff and nurses receive regular enhanced training to compliment their existing qualifications.

Activities & Daily Life

At Ghyll Royd, we enrich lives through a vibrant social calendar, with activities tailored to individual interests, from arts and crafts to musical entertainment. Residents can participate as much or as little as they choose.

Our dedicated minibus and driver facilitate regular outings to local attractions, fostering community connections and creating lasting memories.

Our Residents Network brings residents from across the Spellman Care group together for friendship and shared experiences.

As a Veteran Friendly Framework accredited home, we provide tailored support to our veteran residents, meeting eight rigorous standards. Each home has dedicated Armed Forces Champions, and we host regular Veterans' Events, like our popular veterans' cafes, ensuring our veteran residents' needs are met and their experiences are valued.
