

Springbank Care home is a family-owned and family-run residential care home rooted in the picturesque West Yorkshire town of Silsden.

The home was originally a grand 19th-century residence and was lovingly reopened as a residential care home by Steven Spellman after a multi-year refurbishment finishing in 2017.

As part of the Spellman Care family, we operate with a genuine family feel, ensuring our dedicated team treats every one of our just 40 residents as an extension of their own family.

Located on the doorstep of the stunning Yorkshire Dales, Springbank enjoys stunning views over the valley and surrounding fields, with easy access to historic towns like Ilkley and Skipton.





Our Home

Our home is comprised of four communities, Bluebell, Primrose, Snowdrop and Heather. We offer a small home experience, with just 40 residents, meaning there is a real sense of community within the home.

Our Care

Across all our communities we offer a variety of care services tailored to each residents' individual needs, including general residential care, dementia residential care & short break / respite care.

Getting to know our residents is the key to our person-centred approach to care. Life story work enables us to develop an individual care plan for each resident. For those who require assistance with medication, we have a carefully controlled system to safely manage and review the use of medication, whilst promoting independence. Our experienced, discreet care staff are on hand 24 hours a day to assist as required.



Our Bluebell & Primrose Communities

Providing the same high quality care as on our Bluebell and Snowdrop Communities, and home to just over 10 residents each, Primrose and Heather are secure and safe environments for residents living with dementia.

With a choice of large, spacious and thoughtfully designed communal spaces, residents are encouraged to socialise and interact with each other, promoting a sense of community and belonging.

Outdoor Space

At Springbank, we're fortunate to have stunning views of the Aire Valley and a variety of outdoor spaces for our residents to enjoy. Our secure garden is directly accessible from Bluebell Community and has been expertly designed to provide a relaxing and stimulating environment. Residents can stroll through the garden, admire the flowers and plants, or simply relax on a bench and soak up the sun. With a flat patio area at the top, our front lawn is the perfect place for an afternoon picnic or a game of boules, it's also the ideal spot for a refreshing cup of tea whilst taking in the views.

Activities & Daily Life

At Springbank, we enrich lives through a vibrant social calendar, with activities tailored to individual interests, from arts and crafts to musical entertainment. Residents can participate as much or as little as they choose.

Our dedicated minibus and driver facilitate regular outings to local attractions, fostering community connections and creating lasting memories.

Our Residents Network brings residents from across the Spellman Care group together for friendship and shared experiences.

As a Veteran Friendly Framework accredited home, we provide tailored support to our veteran residents, meeting eight rigorous standards. Each home has dedicated Armed Forces Champions, and we host regular Veterans' Events, like our popular veterans' cafes, ensuring our veteran residents' needs are met and their experiences are valued.
