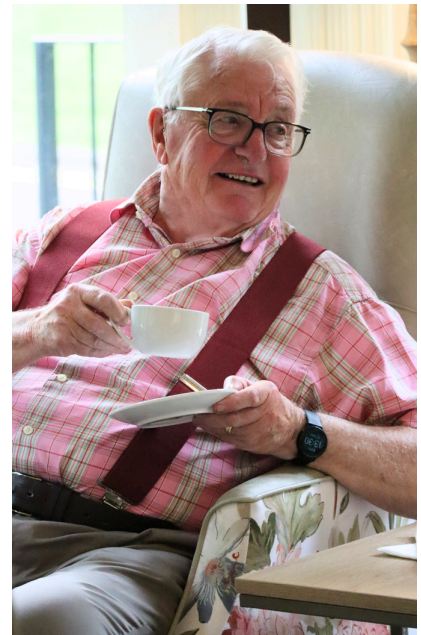

Welcome

Steeton Court is a family-owned nursing home that has been a beacon of trusted care for over 35 years. Established by the Spellman Family, Steeton Court was the very first home to be built and opened by Mick and Tony Spellman, and their enduring vision and dedication continue today under the leadership of Steven Spellman.

As a truly family-run home, we believe in extending our own family values to every aspect of the care we provide. Our ethos is built on warmth, trust, and person-centred care, meaning that when a resident joins Steeton Court, they become an integral part of our family.





Our Home

Steeton Court has three communities, Devonshire, Cavendish and Harewood, across which we can accommodate 61 residents. Our communities are designed to create a safe and positive environment for our residents. All our bedrooms have en-suite facilities and are stylishly decorated. Residents are encouraged to personalise their rooms and make it feel like a home from home. Our communal areas are light and spacious, designed with comfort and social interaction in mind.

Devonshire and Cavendish Communities

Our Devonshire and Cavendish Communities provide 46 residents with General Nursing Care and Palliative Care. Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, our registered nurses and highly trained care staff work closely with local Primary Care Teams to ensure residents receive only the best quality care.

We take great care to get to know residents straight away, understanding their background, likes and needs, always working to improve on each residents personalised care plan.



Harewood Community

Bordered by a tranquil stream and woodland, our Harewood Community supports up to 15 residents living with dementia. Harewood Community boasts an enclosed garden area and conservatory overlooking the woodland, as well as a calming low stimulus sensory lounge.

Residents living on Harewood Community are provided with the same high quality care as our General Nursing Communities, with the addition of Registered Mental Health Nurses.

We take time to get to know our residents as individuals to ensure that we deliver the very best person-centred care. Our Activities Team hold regular dementia friendly, cognitively stimulating activities on Harewood Community, using recollections, reminiscence and sensory-based activities to gain insight into a resident's life stories. Residents will also be invited to take part in the wider activities programme throughout the home, with all care staff being fully trained on dementia and how to support individuals to live well.

We ensure that the environment we offer changes with the needs of our residents, which is why we continually develop Harewood Community with those living with dementia in mind.

Activities & Daily Life

At Steeton Court, we enrich lives through a vibrant social calendar, with activities tailored to individual interests, from arts and crafts to musical entertainment. Residents can participate as much or as little as they choose.

Our dedicated minibus and driver facilitate regular outings to local attractions, fostering community connections and creating lasting memories.

Our Residents Network brings residents from across the Spellman Care group together for friendship and shared experiences.

As a Veteran Friendly Framework accredited home, we provide tailored support to our veteran residents, meeting eight rigorous standards. Each home has dedicated Armed Forces Champions, and we host regular Veterans' Events, like our popular veterans' cafes, ensuring our veteran residents' needs are met and their experiences are valued.


